

WHO DRAWS THE LINES?

✓ NOW

Bipartisan Citizen Commission

- Created by a 2020 constitutional amendment
- Approved directly by 65% of VA voters
- Designed to take power away from politicians

✗ AFTER A “YES” VOTE

Democrat Politicians in the Legislature

- Power shifts back to lawmakers
- Removes voter-approved safeguards

WHEN ARE DISTRICTS DRAWN?

✓ NOW

Every 10 Years

- After the U.S. Census
- Stable, predictable process

✗ AFTER A “YES” VOTE

In 2026 – and Potentially Again Anytime Before 2030

- Not because courts required it
- Simply because politicians choose to

WHAT COULD HAPPEN TO VIRGINIA’S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION?

✓ CURRENTLY

6 Democrats | 5 Republicans

- Competitive balance

✗ AFTER A “YES” VOTE

10 Democrats | 1 Republican

- Major partisan shift
- Likely to tip Congress control to Dems.

Why Vote NO?

Weaponizes the Constitution

This amendment turns Virginia's Constitution into a political tool. Instead of protecting fair maps, it gives lawmakers more power over district lines and weakens trust in the system.

Lets Politicians Choose their Voters

This amendment allows politicians to redraw districts whenever they want — helping them protect their seats and target opponents. It shifts power away from voters and undermines fair elections.

Encourages Partisan Gerrymandering

This amendment would bypass Virginia's bipartisan Redistricting Commission, letting politicians redraw districts for their own gain. It opens the door to extreme partisan gerrymandering, slicing up communities to lock in one-party rule, reducing competition, increasing lawsuits, and eroding trust in our elections.

Ignores the Will of the People

In 2020, more than 65% of Virginians voted to take redistricting power away from politicians and give it to a bipartisan commission. This amendment would reverse that decision — handing control back to lawmakers and ignoring the clear will of the voters.
